• Purpose

• Procedure

- o While working at a clinical site, students must wear professional clothing or scrubs, which may include a lab coat in some settings, and Clinical ID Badge. No open-toe shoes. Apparel and person are expected to be clean without the presence of colognes and perfumes. Tattoos and piercings (other than ear piercings) must not be visible at any time. Please note that clothing requirements designated by the clinical facility supersede those listed here.
